	<p>This Whiskey is exceptionally balanced with a wonderfully mellow, complex taste. A long lingering finish carries the theme of the wood, spice and toffee through to the end. Matured for no less than 18 years in a combination of bourbon and oloroso sherry casks and finished in first fill American bourbon barrels, this is a masterful whiskey of great fluency with a rich, smooth taste. Since its debut in 2002, stocks of Jameson® 18 Year Old Limited Reserve, as its name suggests, are limited in its individually numbered bottles.</p>	
2	Glenlivet 21Year Old	\$110.00
	<p>The Glenlivet® 21 Year Old Archive is a batch produced Whisky using only hand-selected casks. It is a complex Whisky with sherry and wood notes integrating seamlessly with the aromatic palette. Opulent, mature with a sherry influence, this Whisky is an intricate array of wood and fruit with light notes of vanilla and ripe peaches on the nose. Full-bodied with a dry spiciness of cinnamon, ginger, walnut and dark chocolate taste. Everlasting and warming with a lingering presence of hazelnuts and liquorice in the finish.</p>	
3	Glenlivet 25 Year Old	\$350.00
	<p>This 25 Year Old is rich amber in colour with ripe gold hues on the nose. Intense, deep and creamy, this sherry shows itself with luscious fruity and spicy notes on the nose. Enticing scents of exotic wood along with orange crème brûlée and candied fruit with pineapple notes. Silky and caressing on the palate, sweet at first then releasing a full bunch of spices; ginger, cinnamon, allspice, nutmeg and developing dark chocolate and orange peel flavours. Dry and spicy on the finish but keeps teasing the tastebuds all the way through and comes back on a sweeter fruity note.</p>

4	Johnnie Walker Blue "King George the V"	\$689.99
	<p>King George V Edition is named for the King who awarded Johnnie Walker a royal warrant to supply his household with Scotch. Packaged in a crystal decanter and presented in an elegantly lined box with an individually numbered certificate of authenticity, this edition is composed only of whiskies from distilleries that were operating during the reign of King George V. The King George V Edition maintains a delicate balance of peat, smoke, and lighter aromatic fruit flavours from a variety of oak casks.</p>	
5	Brechin 28 Year Old	\$249.99
	<p>The Brechin distillery lies in Brechin on the eastern coast of Scotland. Only 2,040 units of this 2005 bottling were ever released. Deliciously rich-textured, this opulent natural cask-strength Brechin is sophisticated and subtle. Intensely sweet and fruity on the nose, with a wisp of smoke, it is smooth bodied, drying gently to a medium-long fruit and nut finish that lingers agreeably.</p>	
6	1974 Glenfiddich Vintage Reserve	\$999.00
	<p>The 1974 Glenfiddich Vintage Reserve is Glenfiddich's first-ever vatted Vintage Reserve. It is rich and oaky with vibrant vanilla sweetness and an intriguing hint of polished leather and liquorice on the nose. With the addition of a little water there is a burst of fresh fruit and spice, orange marmalade, ripe berries, cinnamon, nutmeg and caramelized pear. The taste is initially very sweet with a vanilla toffee character. The oak tannin develops with time giving it a pleasing, oily texture and a slightly drier flavour. With water, it becomes velvety soft and mellow with beautiful layers of fruit, spice, oak and the merest hint of smoke. Only one thousand limited-edition bottles were released for sale.</p>

7	1973 Glenfiddich Vintage Reserve	\$999.00
	<p>This 1973 Glenfiddich single malt matured for 33 years in second-fill Spanish sherry butts, which was the first time the Distillery used a malt stored in this type of wood for its Vintage Reserve. The dark colour is the deepest of any Vintage Reserve released to date. The nose has rich oak notes, a subtle nuttiness and sherried sweetness that leads to a stunning sweet and spicy sensation upon taste and a warm and lingering finish. A total of 861 bottles have been drawn from the two casks selected.</p>	
8	Two Handcrafted Single Malt Crystal Glasses and Water Thimble	\$223.00
	<p>NovaScotian Crystal is Canada's only maker of mouth-blown, hand-cut crystal. This best selling single malt glass was created by the craftsmen of NovaScotian Crystal right here in Halifax. Through research and testing, the glass was designed to deliver the ultimate experience for the single malt enthusiast.
