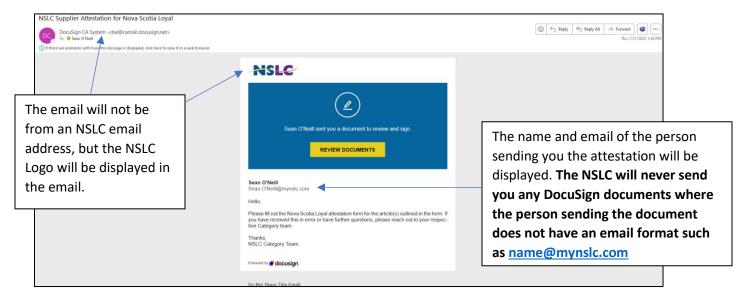
Nova Scotia Loyal Attestation – DocuSign User Guide

The Nova Scotia Loyal Attestation process is put in place by the NSLC for both Beverage Alcohol and Cannabis Suppliers to have the opportunity to carry the Nova Scotia Loyal branding with their products. This process is done through supplier declaration of various criteria based on shopper research that will allow the NSLC to assess if a product can receive the Nova Scotia Loyal classification.

The NSLC will initiate the official process with an email sent through DocuSign.



Note: If you ever have any questions or concerns about whether the email is valid, please contact your Category Team.

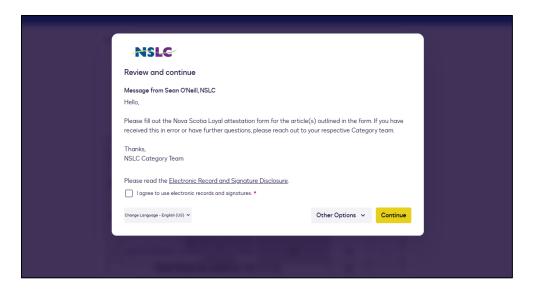
Click on the "Review Document(s)" button in the email. A new browser window will open through your default browser:

DocuSign may prompt you to allow access to your location.

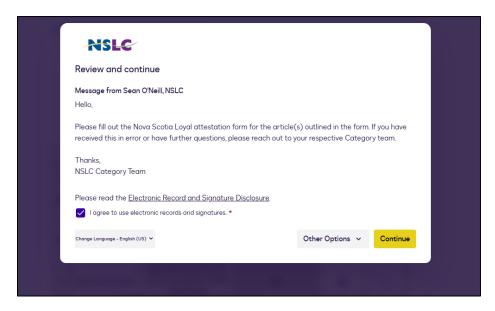


Location can be allowed or denied. NSLC does not require you to disclose your signing location.

After clicking the Allow or Deny button, the following will be displayed:



To proceed with the attestation process, you must agree to the Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ESRD). If you would like to read the Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure in detail, you have the option to click on the link. Check the "I agree to use electronic records and signature" box as shown below.

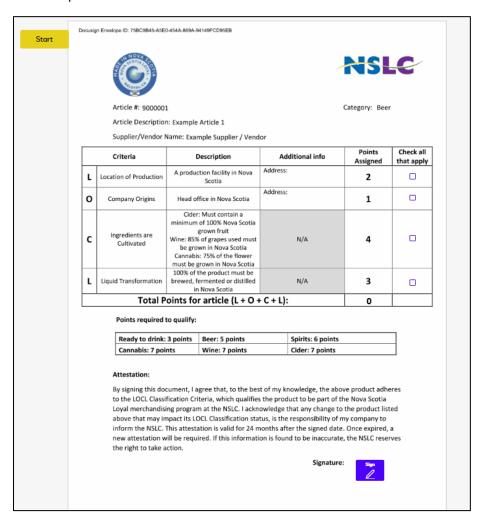


DocuSign will open the Nova Scotia Loyal Attestation Forms for the products the NSLC is looking to assess. Check the boxes that apply to the product listed on each page:

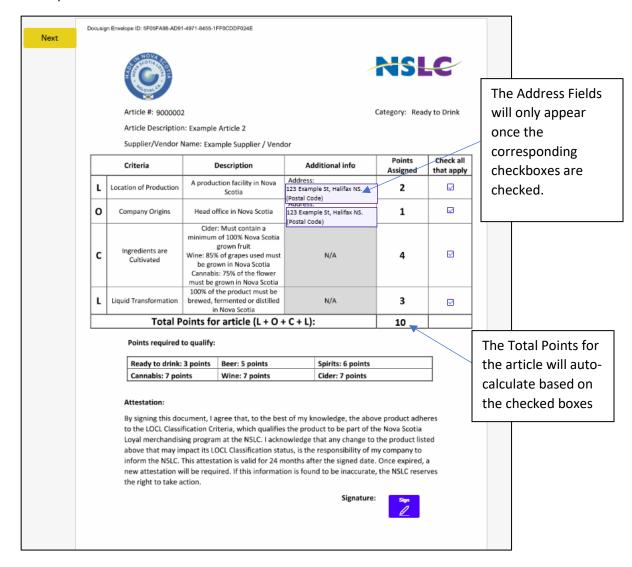
In the following example, we have two products:

- Product 9000001: This product does not meet any of the LOCL criteria.
- Product 9000002: This product meets all the LOCL criteria.

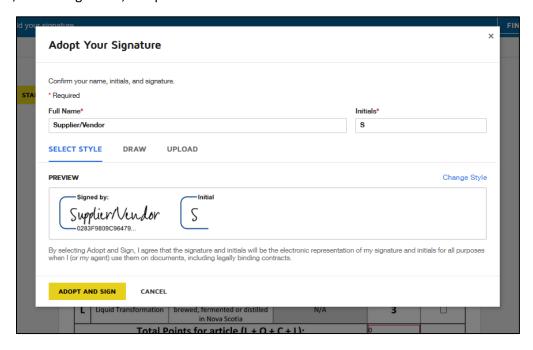
Product 9000001: This product has a score of **0** as it meets no LOCL criteria. See below:



Product 9000002: This product has a score of **10** for LOCL and is populated as below. If your product(s) meet the Location of Production and/or Company Origins criteria, you must fill in the corresponding addresses to complete the attestation. See below:

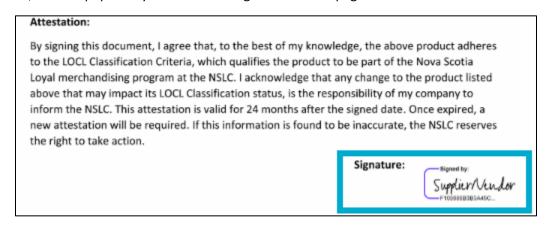


Click on the blue "Sign" button on each page to virtually add your signature, either through the Adopt a Signature, Draw a Signature, or Upload features.

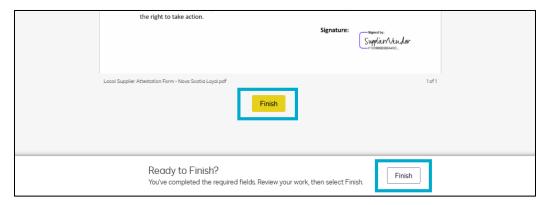


Click on the "Adopt and Sign" button.

Once done, this will populate your electronic signature on the page as shown below:

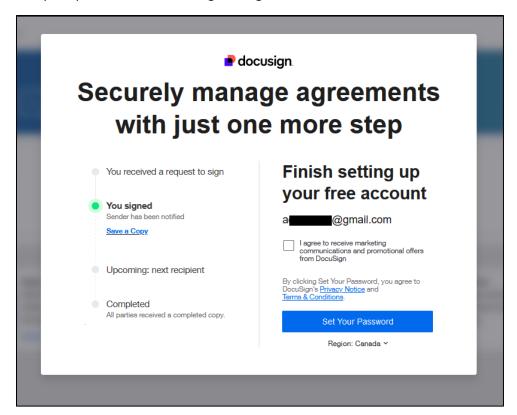


Once all attestation forms are completed and signed, you will see a "Ready to Finish?" notification. Click on either of the "FINISH" buttons as highlighted below:



After clicking on "Finish", the attestation form(s) will be sent to NSLC for review.
