

## **Brew Pub Requirements**

If you are interested in setting up a brew pub in Nova Scotia, please use the following checklist as a guideline of the requirements needed. Please note that all products brewed at a brew pub can only be sold on-premise or in growlers to take off-site; they cannot be sold to licensees nor exported.

Written Proposal to the NSLC	
<ul> <li>A written proposal must be submitted for approval by the NSLC. The Proposal should include:</li> <li>Floor plans and site of proposed Brew Pub</li> <li>Structure of Company: Board of Directors, President, etc.</li> <li>Products to be produced</li> <li>Method of distribution</li> <li>Size and type of containers</li> <li>Production volumes</li> <li>Quality control (including the type of testing equipment you plan to use, how you plan to test the alcohol strength in your product, what lab you plan to use to test the product for alcohol content and safety, your water source, water test results if using a well, cleaning and sterilization process, cleaning schedule, etc.)</li> <li>Alcoholic strength</li> <li>Number of people to be employed</li> <li>Capital costs, etc.</li> <li>Written approval from city/town relative to their zoning, etc.</li> <li>Copy of your federal license from Canada Revenue Agency.</li> </ul>	
Canada Revenue Agency Requirements	
The requirements of the Canada Revenue Agency need to be met, which includes tax requirements and packaging, labeling and quality control of all products.
